Biological Nitrogen Fixation Frans J. de Bruijn, 2015-06-16 Nitrogen is arguably the most important nutrient required by plants However the availability of nitrogen is limited in many soils and although the earth's atmosphere consists of 78.1% nitrogen gas N_2 plants are unable to use this form of nitrogen To compensate modern agriculture has been highly reliant on industrial nitrogen fertilizers to achieve maximum crop
