entitled *The Moslem World* and served as the representative of Islam at the 1893 World's Parliament of Religions in Chicago. In 1901 he was appointed Honorary Turkish Consul General in New York and was invited to Turkey where he received two Ottoman medals of merits. In this first ever biography of Webb Umar F Abd Allah examines Webb's life and uses it as a window through which to explore the early history of Islam in America. Except for his adopted faith, every aspect of Webb's life was as Abd Allah shows quintessentially characteristic of his place and time.
