will know a lot of mechanics and some hardly any I have tried to help the latter without boring the former by putting a summary of the necessary mechanics in an appendix p 140 References from the main text to the appendix will tell readers where they can find help if they need it Figures and equations in the appendix have numbers distinguished by a prefix A for instance Figure A 3
