The Oracle prophesied that Oedipus would murder his father and marry his mother. In an attempt to prevent this prophecy's fulfillment, Laius ordered Oedipus's feet to be bound together and pierced with a stake. Afterwards, the baby was given to a herdsman who was told to kill him. Unable to go through with his orders, he instead gave the child to a second herdsman who took the infant Oedipus to the king of Corinth, Polybus. Polybus adopted Oedipus as his son. Oedipus was raised as the crown prince of Corinth. Many years later, Oedipus was told that Polybus was not his real father. Seeking the truth, he sought counsel from an Oracle and thus started the greatest tragedy ever written.

servant takes the baby to a mountain top to die from exposure A shepherd rescues the infant and names him Oedipus or swollen feet The servant directly hands the infant to the shepherd in most versions The shepherd carries the baby with him to Corinth where Oedipus is taken in and raised in the court of the childless King Polybus of Corinth as if he were his own
