

## Organisms & Evolution //

**Microbiology:** The study of living things too small to see with the naked eye.

- The four main divisions of life are bacteria, archaea, eukaryotes, and viruses.
- Each division's DNA is more similar to its own than to any of the other three.

### Bacteria

- Were the first cells on Earth.
- Contain over 50 different phyla (major groupings).
- Are the most abundant form of life.
  - People have more bacteria growing on/in them than human cells.
- Incredibly diverse.
  - There are thousands of different species in one gram of soil.
- Live in most environments, including the deep sea, underground, and terrestrial.

### Archaea

- Relatively uncommon with fewer known species.
  - Most common in extreme environments (e.g., deep-sea vents and high salinity lakes).
- Combine some features of prokaryotes and eukaryotes.
- Often known as extremophiles and will grow when other organisms cannot.
  - ENO: Halophiles, salt loving; sulfophiles, sulfur loving; thermotrophs, heat loving; lithotrophs, rock loving; methanophiles, methane loving (ruminant guts).

### Eukaryotes

- May be single cells (e.g., yeast, algae, and amoebas) or multicellular (e.g., fungi, plants, and animals).
  - Contain membrane-bound subcompartments that separate specific functions, particularly the nucleus.
  - Division includes microscopic organisms previously belonging to the Monera kingdom.

### Viruses

- Many feel viruses are not alive as they are obligate parasites and cannot replicate without other cells.
- Different viruses target all three domains.
- Viruses may use DNA or RNA as genetic material and use molecules from the host cell to make more virus particles, ultimately killing the host.

## Shapes & Types //

### Bacterial & Archeal Cell Shapes & Growth Characteristics

- Cocci:** Spherical
- Bacilli:** Rod-shaped
- Spirilla:** Spiral-shaped
- Pleomorphic:** Multiple shapes are possible



- Diplo-:** Prefix meaning two; a diplococcus is two cocci that have grown together.
- Tetrad:** Four cocci that grow together in a plane.
- Sarcinae:** Eight cocci that grow together in a cube.
- Strepto-:** Prefix meaning chain; a streptococcus is cocci that have grown together in a chain.
- Staphylo-:** Prefix meaning cluster; a staphylococcus is cocci that have grown together in a cluster.

### Eukaryotic Types

- Ciliates:** Short cilia used for locomotion and/or feeding.
- Flagellates:** Long flagella used for locomotion; usually there are only one or two per cell.
- Slime molds:** Single cells living in a damp environment (e.g., under leaves in a forest) that come together during replication.



- Amoeba:** Free-form cell that can change its shape and engulf its prey.
- Protist:** Non-plant, non-fungi organism (e.g., ciliates and flagellates).
- Algae:** Photosynthetic organism with a nuclei and chloroplasts. Many are single cells, others are multicellular, but many forms are still microscopic (i.e., volvox).
- Diatoms:** Photosynthetic eukaryote with a silicate cell wall often with a complex symmetrical pattern.
- Yeast:** Eukaryotic, single-celled, round fungi.
- Mush:** Multicellular fungus which forms hair-like projections (hyphae) that may contain crosswalls (septate) or not (non-septate).

### Viral Shapes

- Helical:** Spiral arrangement of protein capsid molecules that can appear rod-shaped.
