



### Sculptural Form and Hyperbole

Following the lead of Le Corbusier, Kurihara (1915) and Hasegawa started to pursue a sculptural architecture, while the Late Modernists took off in a more gently sculpted direction. During the 1960s they used reinforced concrete in a very expressive way and the trend continued, leading to the extremes. Sometimes the result, one dimension and performing, more often they make use of the rhetorical device hyperbole, and exaggerate forms to move to their point, oversteering away.
