perform security and resilience missions This book argues that only a Network Federal governance will provide unity of effort to mature the Homeland Security Enterprise The places to start implementing network federal mechanisms are in the ten FEMA regions To that end it recommends establishment of Regional Preparedness Staffs composed of Federal state and local personnel serving as co equals on Intergovernmental Personnel Act IPA rotational assignments These IPAs would form the basis of an intergovernmental and interdisciplinary homeland security professional cadre to build a collaborative national preparedness culture As facilitators of regional unity of effort with regard to prioritization of risk planning resourcing and operational execution these Regional Preparedness Staffs would provide the Nation with decentralized network nodes enabling security and resilience in this 21st century post industrial strategic environment **Theoretical Foundations of** Homeland Security James D.
