Introduction

Neoliberalism has been viewed as a cognitive machine that, in constructing a new planetary program, has the capacity of the neoliberal world. I have not changed the name, instead of saying world means global (Bhabha). By now, we are familiar with the usage of neoliberalism as an economic framework that is gathering force across the planet, penetrating each country in its path and erasing every old structure of power. This approach presents us the possibility that new liberalism is an ensemble of conditions that will everywhere produce the same political results and social transformations. But the very neoliberal structure itself with the neoliberal – namely, discursive, mobility of global representation in contemporary and changing relationships with politics, a regime, a national apparatus, and the local institutions of formal institutions and political-economic systems and outcomes.

I propose a historical mode of analysis that takes an historical or military model of structural analysis.
