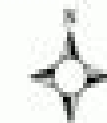

record With this purpose in view he has set forth such results of modern investigation as may render the sacred narrative more intelligible and attractive Many of the difficulties which are daily being raised on historical grounds are also touched upon and the biblical student is supplied with constant references to further sources of information Like the historical writings of the New Testament the present volume contains two distinct though very closely connected parts The first part gathered from the four narratives of our canonical gospels describes the life and times of Our Lord the second based mainly on the book of the Acts presents a brief sketch of the labors of Peter Paul James and John the leading apostles of Christ The first part under the title of The Gospel History takes up the sacred narrative at the point where it was left in the Outlines of Jewish History and deals with the three and thirty years of Our Lord s mortal life i the second entitled The Apostolic History narrates the principal events connected with the planting and early spread of Christianity in the Roman Empire down to the year 98 A D As an additional help to the student two maps one of Palestine in the Time of Our Lord the other of the Roman Empire in the Apostolic Times have been especially prepared and will be found at the end of the volume together with a Chronological Table established on the now commonly admitted fact that the birth of Our Lord took place some years before what is called the Christian era
