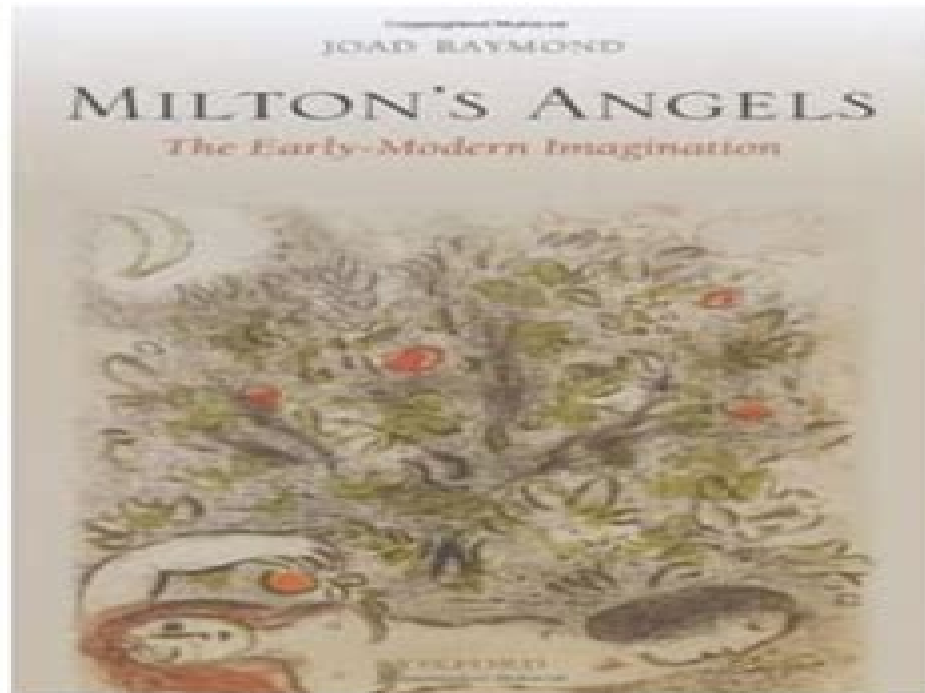

Milton's Angels Joad Raymond, 2010-02-25 Milton's *Paradise Lost* the most eloquent most intellectually daring most learned and most sublime poem in the English language is a poem about angels. It is told by and of angels; it relies upon their conflicts, communications, and miscommunications. They are the creatures of Milton's narrative through which he sets the Fall of humankind against a cosmic background.
