With increased globalization and integration of financial and energy markets with agricultural commodity markets, the relationships between markets are expanding and becoming more complex. When a crisis, such as a regional drought, food safety scare, or a financial crisis, hits a particular market, policy makers often do not know the extent to which it will impact on other markets and affect producer, consumer, and trader decisions. Including contributions from experts at the World Bank, the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, the USDA, and the European Commission, the research developed throughout the chapters of this book is based on current methodologies that can be used to analyze price volatility and provide directions for understanding this volatility and the development of new agricultural policies. The book highlights the challenges facing policy makers in dealing with the changing nature of agricultural commodities markets and offers recommendations for anticipating price movements and managing their consequences. It will be a practical guide for both present and future policy makers in deciding on potential price stabilizing interventions and will also serve as a useful resource for researchers and students in agricultural economics.
