awareness of the historical roots of our beliefs and biases can allow us as individuals or as a society to escape or transcend them Specifically he turns to the movement for reform of legal studies and insists that a dream of a legal culture in which no one's values are slighted or declared peripheral can no more be realized than the dream of a concept of fairness that answers to everyone's notions of equality and justice or a yardstick of merit that is true to everyone's notions of worth and substance Similarly he argues that attempts to politicize the study of literature are ultimately misguided because recharacterizations of literary works have absolutely no impact on the mainstream of political life He concludes his critique of the academy with *The Unbearable Ugliness of Volvos* an extraordinary look at some of the more puzzling if not out and out masochistic characteristics of a life in academia Penetrating fearless and brilliantly argued *There's No Such Thing as Free Speech* captures the essential Fish It is must reading for anyone who cares about the outcome of America's cultural wars
