Title

The title itself, Nursing Care Misses is clearly ambiguous, lacking in enough information. The title can give meaning to several things, all of which may not even be connected to the specified paper work. The scenario being studied on is clearly evident, but the population being studied was omitted. Further information could have been explained in the title alone so as to inform the possible readers about the content of the article.

Abstract

The abstract answered two of the research questions that were stated in the first sentence of the article. The study findings were also listed as part of the abstract, describing the nursing care misses. In the latter part, it is stated that there were seven themes found though not listed explicitly. These proved to be the reasons that nurses provide as to why they were not able to provide the needed nursing care expected of them. The abstract proved to be shorter than a standard abstract. As explained by Beckham and Paul (2010), abstracts are generally between 100–200 words. Even though it may be brief, all major points are summarized here.

Method

Protection of the rights of the participants. The techniques are explicitly identified in this part of the paper. The methods used for data analysis and data collection are thoroughly explained. The participants are CAN's, RN's and LPN's in the hospital. They were asked to keep the study confidential. However, they were required to speak with all honestly about ignoring the need to perform regular aspects of the everyday jobs together with their peers.

Research Tradition and Design. This section explains the research tradition used in the paper. The author clearly uses an approach for grounded theory with which data are categorized thematically by means of induction. Data was then analyzed twice, and there were found themes that were similar. Collection of data using the grounded theory is appropriately done for both group and single interviews.
