

Précis of *Moral Dimensions: Permissibility, Meaning, Blame*

Moral Dimensions is concerned with the way in which an agent's aims in acting, and more generally what he or she sees as reasons for acting in that particular way, are relevant to the permissibility of that action, or to other forms of moral assessment. As the title indicates, one central theme of the book is the importance of distinguishing different forms of moral assessment, some of which depend on agents' reasons for acting in ways that other forms of assessment do not.

Chapter 1 is concerned with whether an agent's reasons are relevant to the permissibility of an action in the way claimed by the Doctrine of Double Effect. I have never found this doctrine intrinsically plausible. But for many years I was inclined to accept it because it seemed to provide the only satisfactory explanation of certain cases. It seemed, for example, to be the best explanation of the distinction between tactical bombing and terror bombing. It also seemed to explain why it is permissible to use the all of the available amount of a drug to save five people even though this means that another person, who could be saved only by giving him all of the available supply, will die, but not permissible to withhold all of the drug from that person in order to save five others by transplanting his organs after he has died.

In this chapter I argue that there are other, better explanations of these cases. The tendency to think that they support the Doctrine of Double Effect arises, I suggest, from a failure to distinguish between two ways of employing a moral principle to assess what an agent has done: what I call the *deliberative* use of a principle, to determine the permissibility of acting in this way, and the *critical* use of a principle, to assess the way in which the agent went about deciding what to do. The latter form of assessment always depends on what the agent saw as reasons whereas the former need not do so.

cognitive and volitional capacities normative competence and a fair opportunity to exercise these capacities free from undue interference situational control Because our reactive attitudes and practices presuppose the fair opportunity conception of responsibility this supports a predominantly retributive conception of blame and punishment that treats culpable wrongdoing as the desert basis of blame and punishment We can then apply the fair opportunity framework to assessing responsibility and excuse in circumstances of structural injustice situational influences in ordinary circumstances and in wartime insanity and psychopathy immaturity addiction and crimes of passion Though fair opportunity has important implications for each issue treating them together allows us to explore common themes and appreciate the need to take partial responsibility and excuse seriously in our practices of blame and punishment

McKenna,2012-03-28 In this book Michael McKenna advances a new theory of moral responsibility one that builds upon the work of P F Strawson As McKenna demonstrates moral responsibility can be explained on analogy with a conversation The relation between a morally responsible agent and those who hold her morally responsible is similar to the relation between a speaker and her audience A responsible agent's actions are bearers of meaning agent meaning just as a speaker's utterances are bearers of speaker meaning Agent meaning is a function of the moral quality of the will with which the agent acts Those who hold an agent morally responsible for what she does do so by responding to her as if in a conversation By responding with certain morally reactive attitudes such as resentment or indignation they thereby communicate their regard for the meaning taken to be revealed in that agent's actions It is then open for the agent held responsible to respond to those holding her responsible by offering an apology a justification an excuse or some other response thereby extending the evolving conversational exchange The conversational theory of moral responsibility that McKenna develops here accepts two features of Strawson's theory that moral responsibility is essentially interpersonal so that being responsible must be understood by reference to the nature of holding responsible and that the moral emotions are central to holding responsible While upholding these two aspects of Strawson's theory McKenna's theory rejects a further Strawsonian thesis which is that holding morally responsible is more fundamental or basic than being morally responsible On the conversational theory the conditions for holding responsible are dependent on the nature of the agent who is responsible So holding responsible cannot be more basic than being responsible Nevertheless the nature of the agent who is morally responsible is to be understood in terms of sensitivity to those who would make moral demands of her thereby holding her responsible Being responsible is therefore also dependent on holding responsible Thus neither being nor holding morally responsible is more basic than the other They are mutually dependent
