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web expert verified chem 182 determining the ksp of calcium hydroxide calcium hydroxide is an ionic solid that is sparingly soluble in water a saturated aqueous solution of Ca(OH)_2 is represented in equation form as shown below $\text{Ca(OH)}_2 \rightleftharpoons \text{Ca}^{2+} + 2\text{OH}^-$ the solubility product expression describes in mathematical terms the equilibrium

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web ksp for calcium hydroxide calcium hydroxide is a soft white caustic powder used in making mortar cements calcium salts paints and petrochemicals it is also used in saltwater aquaria to make up kalkwasser limewater solutions for reef tanks and is used as a pH regulating agent notice that calcium hydroxide is divalent and thus has twice
