The Thought of Matter Richard A. Lee Jr., 2015-12-18 Discussions of materialism have exploded in recent years. From the speculative realism materialism of Quentin Meillassoux to the New Materialism of many modern Marxisms, the interest in a return to or rehabilitation of materialism is on the rise. What is not analyzed in many of these discussions, however, is a trenchant methodological and metaphysical problem lying at the basis of any philosophical materialism: if matter is simply that which is other than thought, then how can it be thought without drawing it away from its materiality? On the other hand, if one assumes a direct access to matter, to this other, what are the conditions of that access? Are they material conditions or cognitive thought conditions? Does what would present itself immediately present at the same time the conditions that allow it to be presented? If not, then we are closer to a theology of matter and further from a philosophical materialism. *The Thought of Matter* investigates this metaphysical and methodological problem through Aristotle, Marx, Adorno, Althusser, Duns Scotus, Hobbes, and Benjamin in order to show that a philosophical materialism necessarily requires the concepts and tools of thought in order to allow the otherness of matter to emerge in its own materiality.

Ontology and Dialectics Theodor W. Adorno, 2018-12-21 Adorno's lectures on ontology and dialectics from 1960-61 comprise his most sustained and systematic analysis of Heidegger's philosophy They also represent a continuation of a project that he shared with Walter Benjamin to demolish Heidegger Following the publication of the latter's magnum opus *Being and Time* and long before his notorious endorsement of Nazism at Freiburg University both Adorno and Benjamin had already rejected Heidegger's fundamental ontology After his return to Germany from his exile in the United States Adorno became Heidegger's principal intellectual adversary engaging more intensively with his work than with that of any other contemporary philosopher Adorno regarded Heidegger as an extremely limited thinker and for that reason all the more dangerous In these lectures he highlights Heidegger's increasing fixation with the concept of ontology to show that the doctrine of being can only truly be understood through a process of dialectical thinking

Rather than exploiting overt political denunciation Adorno deftly highlights the connections between Heidegger's philosophy and his political views and in doing so offers an alternative plea for enlightenment and rationality These seminal lectures in which Adorno dissects the thought of one of the most influential twentieth century philosophers will appeal to students and scholars in philosophy and critical theory and throughout the humanities and social sciences

works of the late 1960s are deeply informed by a distinctively modernist vision of human experience This book seeks to establish that Adorno's unique and lasting contribution to philosophy consists in his sustained and rigorous development of this modernist vision into an encompassing practice of philosophical interpretation The essential features of this vision can be discerned in all of Adorno's major writings in philosophy social theory and aesthetics Its defining element is the idea of a pattern underlying ordinary experience which although not directly accessible can be disclosed by the reconstructive work of philosophical or literary language This vision Foster argues can be discerned in the major works of literary modernism including Woolf Proust and Musil as well as in the interpretive technique of psychoanalysis developed by Sigmund Freud The importance of Adorno's contribution to twentieth century philosophy can only be fully appreciated by understanding how he developed this vision into an overarching practice of philosophical interpretation that furnished a coherent and profound response to the decay of experience afflicting late modern societies In this book Foster expounds that interpretive practice exploring its ramifications and in particular its relation with literary modernism and places it in critical dialogue with alternative philosophical responses

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
