Kelley's cause intensified as the violence of the Mexican Revolution and the Cristero Rebellion reverberated across national borders. Kelley's work with the U.S. Catholic Church to intervene in Mexico helped transfer cultural ownership of Mexico from Spain to the United States, thus signaling that Catholics were considered not foreigners but heirs to the land of their Catholic forefathers.

*Shadow of a Taxman* R. J. C. Adams, 2022-03-21 *Shadow of a Taxman* investigates how the unrecognised Irish Republic's money was solicited, collected, transmitted and safeguarded, as well as who the financial backers were and what might have influenced their decision to contribute. The Republic's quest for funds took its emissaries as far afield as New York, Buenos Aires, Cape Town and Melbourne, as well as virtually every parish in Ireland. By selling war bonds to supporters, it raised 370,165 from 140,000 people in Ireland and nearly 6m from 300,000 people in the United States.
