Edwards, Philippe Colomban, 2025-01-27 The use of natural mineral and synthetic blue pigments in antiquity for wall paintings and illuminated manuscript historiography evolved into the most suitable blue pigments for the decoration of glazed and enamelled wares: ceramics, glass, and metal, which required a stability at the high temperatures of the kilns used for glazing and firing. Historic literature is often vague regarding the blue pigments used for this purpose. The generic term cobalt blue covers a wide range of pigments that were actually used for the decoration of faience, majolica, stonewares, earthenwares, and porcelains.
