Clinical neuropsychologists are psychologists who typically utilize standardized tests while behavioral neurologists are physicians who generally assess brain function as part of the clinical neurological evaluation. Both approaches have much to offer. The basic assumption of neuropsychological assessment is that the brain is the organ of behavior and therefore the condition of the brain may be evaluated with behavioral measures. Neuropsychological tests are those measures found by research to be particularly sensitive to alterations in brain function. An adequate neuropsychological test is a procedure that can be related to some objective measure of alteration in brain function. Over the years these objective measures have changed but generally involve documentation through direct observation of brain tissue or through histological pathological neuroimaging or other laboratory procedures. The methods described in the first two volumes of this series describe the neuroimaging procedures that are often used in the validation of neuropsychological tests.
