Noir started to come in it became increasingly clear to us that what was taking shape was not just some collection of dark stories set in old Stamboul but a rich portrait of the city itself or at the very least a particularly revealing series of snapshots. Although Ankara may be the capital of the Republic of Turkey the truth of the matter is with a good twelve million people and thus a fifth of its population Istanbul is the throbbing often bleeding heart of the country's politics. And it shows. Lying at the crossroads of East and West Istanbul belongs to neither and to both and it is precisely this elusive in betweenness upon which the city thrives.
