Once only a topic among women in the private sphere, motherhood and mothering have become important intellectual topics across academic disciplines. Even so, no book has yet devoted a sustained look at how exploring mothering rhetorics, the rhetorics of reproduction, rhetorics about the reproductive function of women, mothers, and reproducing rhetorics, the rhetorical reproduction of ideological systems and logics of contemporary culture, expand our understanding of mothering, motherhood, communication, and gender. *Mothering Rhetorics* begins to fill this gap for scholars and teachers interested in the study of mothering rhetorics in their historical and contemporary permutations. Enduring Shame Heather Brook Adams, 2022-05-17 A study of the rhetorical power of shame and its effect on reproductive politics Not long ago unmarried pregnant women in the United States hid in maternity homes and relinquished their illegitimate children to more deserving two parent families all to conceal shameful pregnancies Although times have changed reproductive politics remain fraught In *Enduring Shame* Heather Brook Adams recasts the 1960s and 70s an era of presumed progress as a time when expanding reproductive rights were paralleled by communicative practices of shame that cultivated increasingly public interventions into unwed and teen pregnancy and new forms of injustice Drawing from personal interviews archival documents legal decisions public policy journalism memoirs and advocacy writing Adams articulates how the rhetorical power of shame persuaded the American public to think about reproduction sexual righteousness and unwed pregnancy Despite the aspirational goals of reproductive liberation public sentiment frequently reflected supremacist beliefs regarding racial economic and moral fitness notions that informed new public policy *Enduring Shame* maps a range of experiences across these decades from women's experiences in homes for unwed mothers to policy and legal changes that are typically understood as proof of shame's dissipation including Title IX legislation and *Roe v Wade* Rhetorical historiography and questions of reproductive justice guide the analysis and women's testimonies provide essential perspectives and context Through these histories Adams articulates a network of language affect and embodiment through which shame moves expands rhetorical understandings of the discursive power of the identities of woman and mother and considers how the gendered raced and classed aspects of shame can help us understand and support reproductive dignity *Enduring Shame* recovers a misunderstood part of women's recent history by considering why reproductive politics continue to be so volatile despite previous gains and why shame still figures centrally in discourse about women's reproductive and sexual freedoms

Birth controlled analyses the world of selective reproduction the politics of who gets to legitimately reproduce the future through a cross cultural analysis of three modes of controlling birth contraception reproductive violence and repro genetic technologies It argues that as fertility rates decline worldwide the fervour to control fertility and fertile bodies does not dissipate what evolves is the preferred mode of control Although new technologies like those that assist conception or allow genetic selection may appear to be an antithesis of other violent versions of population control this book demonstrates that both are part of the same continuum All population control policies target and vilify women Black women in particular and coerce them into subjecting their bodies to state and medical surveillance *Birth controlled* argues that assisted reproductive technologies and repro genetic technologies employ a similar and stratified burden of blame and responsibility based on gender race class and caste To empirically and historically ground the analysis the book includes contributions from two postcolonial nations South Africa and India examining interactions between the history of colonialism and the economics of neoliberal markets and their influence on the technologies and politics of selective reproduction The book provides a critical interdisciplinary and cutting edge dialogue around the interconnected issues that shape reproductive politics in an ostensibly post population control era The contributions draw on a breadth of disciplines ranging from gender studies sociology medical anthropology politics and science and technology studies to theology public health and epidemiology facilitating an interdisciplinary dialogue around the interconnected modes of controlling birth and practices of neo eugenics
