Of Mice and Men, written by John Steinbeck is a compelling novella about loyalty and the hearty American Dream. This literary text entails the story of Lennie and George and their dream of living "off the Fatta the land." This novella is set in Soledad (California) in the 1930's during the Great Depression. George and Lennie are on the move between farms looking to make a fortune great enough to acquire their own ranch; however Lennie's inability to keep out of trouble restricts their dream from playing a part in their reality.

Steinbeck opens this story with "A few miles south of Soledad, the Salinas River drops in close to the hillside bank and runs deep and green. The water is warm too, for it has slipped twinkling over the yellow sands-." This is called imagery and the audience immediately feels the warmth of the sun shining down on grassy rich land. In two sentences Steinbeck has unraveled so much information about the setting for the reader. Another way Steinbeck sets the background is his approach to dialogue. "Lennie. You gonna be sick like you was last night" explains exactly what is happening in colloquial language. We can picture a time of countryside freedom and disorientation. Men with nowhere to go lost in their own lives and dreams.

Steinbeck often uses similes when George describes Lennie "You're like a kid Lennie," referring to Lennie as a child. A technique not often used in novel of Steinbeck's time is direct characterization. On page 21 we read "He stepped short, quick steps, of a fat legged man." This sets a characteristic of a character often through movement or actions.

Foreshadowing is a great technique of in this novella. In the opening chapter, George tells Lennie that if he gets into any trouble to go back and hide in the brush by the river. The other two major foreshadowing events are Lennie killing the mouse and the puppy. Foreshadowing is a useful way of indirectly hinting to the reader that something is yet to come.

Although this is a short novella, Steinbeck still manages to paint descriptive detail. "The afternoon sun sliced in through the cracks of the barn walls." In one sentence he has managed to set the mood and feeling of what will soon become the most important room of the novella. The setting of the barn helps the murder of Curlie's wife seem much more innocent and not so gruesome.

There are standout themes in this bestseller novella. These themes encompass the story and give it clarity. Two of the many themes include Loyalty and Dreams.

Loyalty plays a key role in 'Of Mice and Men.' From the start, the reader learns that George and Lennie have been together since boyhood, and their relationship has been tested many times.
