Once such technologies are available there will be a rapid implementation process that will present many business opportunities for the private sector However in addition to terrorist threats water and wastewater systems are inherently vulnerable to natural disasters such as earthquakes and floods This volume will address the problems associated with both intended terrorist attacks and natural disasters affecting water or wastewater systems.
