congregational use since they were destined to be superseded In addition to these the hymn Hymnum dicat turba fratrum Let your hymn be sung ye faithful has been most persistently associated with Hilary's name. The earliest text occurs in a seventh century manuscript It is a metrical version of the life of Jesus in seventy four lines written in the same meter as that of Adae carnis gloriosae
