1. ANKH

The Ankh symbol is ancient Egypt's most widely recognized symbol, representing life and immortality.

2. EYE OF HORUS

The Eye of Horus symbolizes protection and good health in ancient Egypt. It was also referred to as the moon's symbol. The Eye of Horus amulets was believed to have healing powers in ancient Egypt.



3. EYE OF RA

The Eye of Ra symbol is a subject of debate. Most experts believe that the ancient Egyptians used this symbol to represent the right eye of Horus, which they called the Eye of Ra.

4. SCARAB SYMBOL

The ancient Egyptians revered the Scarab beetle as a sacred symbol. The dung beetle, also known as the Scarab beetle, represented the Sun, rebirth, resurrection, and transformation.



5. DJED PILLAR

Known as "the backbone of Osiris," the Djed Pillar is one of the ancient Egyptian symbols of strength and stability in ancient Egyptian culture.

6. HEKHA AND NEKHAKHA

The Crook "Hekha (HqA)," which is also an epithet of Osiris, means "to rule." It symbolizes the state's control over its people in ancient Egypt.
