These exercises were necessary to develop a combat capability The results of this study demonstrate that the United States government had an interest in

developing an offensive naval combat capability as early as the 1870 s Based on the record of the North Atlantic Squadron it is argued that imperial aspirations in the sense of possessing a capability to restrict the actions of other great powers in the Caribbean region existed prior to the War of 1898 However the process of change often resulted in the appearance of capability without the rigorous exercise necessary to possess it
