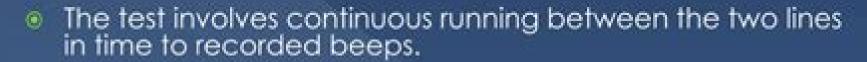
# Pacer Test
