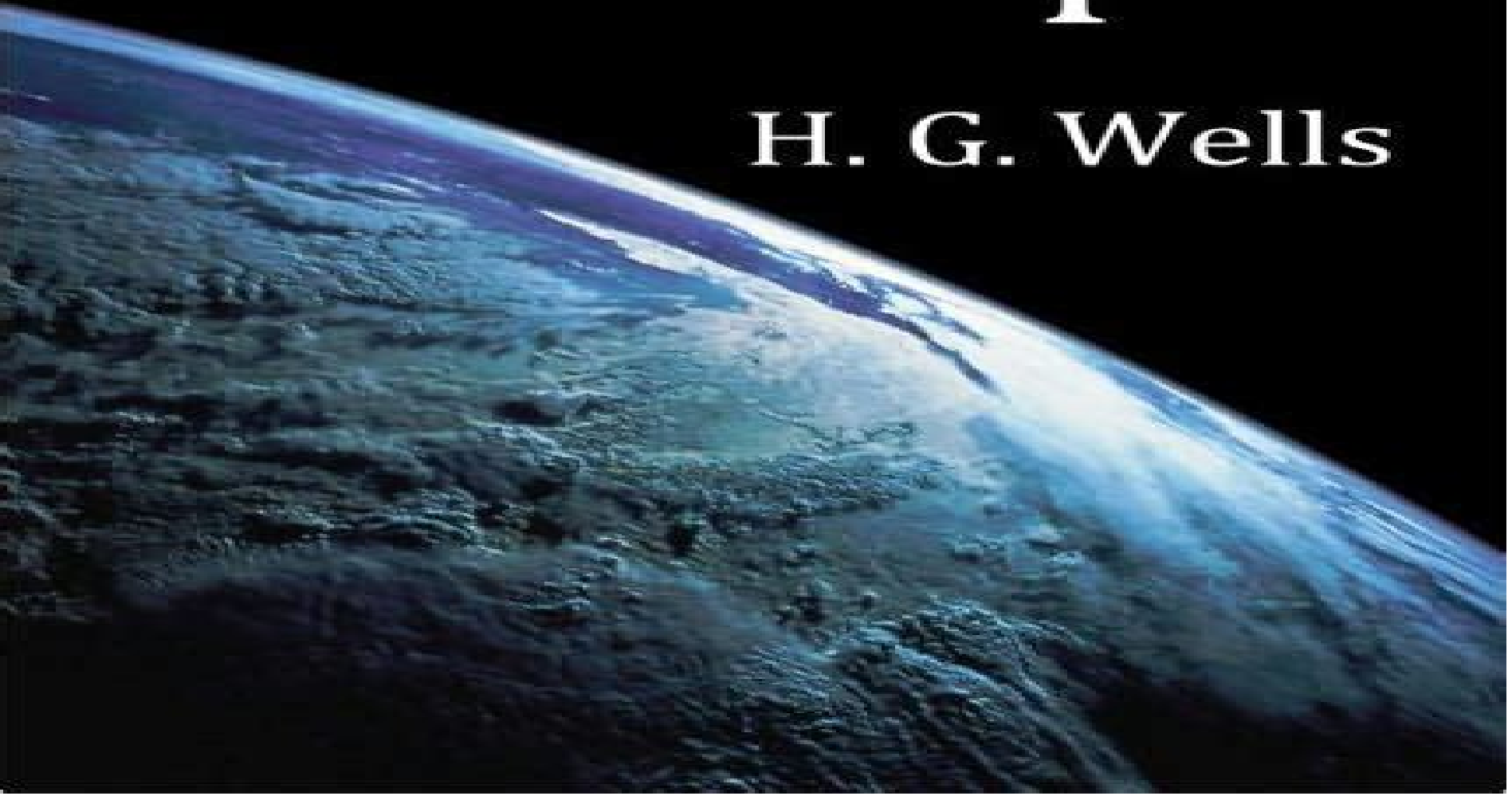

Ursula K Le Guin's *The Dispossessed* is of interest to political theorists partly because of its association with anarchism and partly because it is thought to represent a turning point in the history of utopian dystopian political thought and literature and of science fiction. Published in 1974 it marked a revival of utopianism after decades of dystopian writing. According to this widely accepted view *The Dispossessed* represents a new kind of literary utopia which Tom Moylan calls a critical utopia. The present work challenges this reading of *The Dispossessed* and its place in the histories of utopian dystopian literature and science fiction.
