

Cathy L. Irade, *Modernismo, Modernity, and the Development of Spanish American Literature*. Austin: University of Texas Press, 1998.

El principal propósito del trabajo de Irade es confirmar la dimensión política del modernismo hispanoamericano. Lo peculiar en él es que tal tarea no se lleva a cabo mediante el acostumbrado recurso a textos explícitamente comprometidos con causas extraliterarias, a textos como la "Oda a Roosevelt", por ejemplo; esos ensayos, en definitiva, no alteran la concepción preciosista del modernismo, pues en el fondo siguen asumiéndola como variante canónica y acaban convirtiendo lo político del modernismo en una especie de apéndice temático. Lo que aquí se propone es algo distinto, que un cuento como "La Ninfa" está tan lleno de compromiso como la "Oda a Roosevelt", que lo político no es algo añadido o incorporado *a posteriori*, o un fruto maduro del modernismo, sino algo esencial a él, identificado con él, y, lo más importante, conscientemente querido y buscado por sus escritores desde los inicios del "movimiento". En este sentido, y aunque con conclusiones individualmente distintas, los postulados de Irade coincidirían con los de *The Politics of Spanish American Modernism*, el reciente trabajo de Gerard Arching, donde los modernistas serían portadores de una agenda política con intenciones nacionalistas o pan-hispanistas. Si los primeros lectores del modernismo no captaron su carga política se debió, según Irade, a la imagen de frivolidad y superficialidad que de él transmitieron los autores de segunda fila, y si a nosotros también nos ha costado entenderlo así, ha sido a causa de la persistencia de la crítica formalista y sociológica, las cuales, de modo diferente, han seguido confinando la literatura modernista al reducho de lo literario o la han interpretado bajo la "teoría del reflejo". En estas coordenadas el carácter político del modernismo tendría una doble manifestación, inseparable de su origen. Por un lado el modernismo sería la primera confrontación de Hispanoamérica con la modernidad, es decir, el primer y conflictivo diálogo entre el capitalismo, esa visión compartimentada e inorgánica de la vida, y la conciencia crítica de escritores e intelectuales hispanoamericanos. Es obvio que en el contexto sociopolítico y económico que es la modernidad, la respuesta literaria correspondiente (el modernismo) no puede sino encontrarse condicionada y orientada por las referencias que ese sistema le marque, no puede no ser política. Por ello se explica que los modos literarios latinoamericanos posteriores al modernismo sean en cierta manera una proyección suya, en cuanto que siguen recogiendo esa siempre conflictiva e inacabada instalación de subcontinente en la pos/modernidad. Por lo tanto, el lenguaje modernista sería esencialmente el lenguaje de una crisis, y esto en el sentido en que ya fue expuesto por Julio Ramón, es decir, en cuanto vehículo de esa confrontación ideológica, pero también por las implicaciones de su condición analógica, que harían de él un medio apropiado para la recuperación de las armonías sociales y epistemológicas desaparecidas con el advenimiento de la modernidad. Igualmente, en cuanto la construcción de ese lenguaje tiene lugar mediante el distanciamiento voluntario del lenguaje de la antigua metrópoli y también mediante un verdadero cosmopolitismo cultural, el resultado no puede sino implicar una reformulación de la identidad nacional o supranacional, un intento de reubicación de Hispanoamérica en el nuevo contexto mundial. Y esto es, evidentemente, otro objetivo político. Y, en cuanto que su sincretismo se extendería más allá de lo puramente literario, abarcando no sólo las expresiones literarias románticas, realistas o simbolistas, sino también
