**Molly Spotted Elk** Bunny McBride,1997-09-01 This biography chronicles the extraordinary life of twentieth century performing artist Molly Spotted Elk Born in 1903 on the Penobscot reservation in Maine Molly ventured into show business at an early age performing vaudeville in New York starring in the classic docudrama The Silent Enemy then dancing for royalty and mingling with the literary elite in Europe In Paris she found an audience more appreciative of authentic Native dance than in the United States There she married a French journalist but she was forced to leave him and flee France with her daughter during the German occupation of 1940 Using extensive diaries in conjunction with letters interviews and other sources Bunny McBride reconstructs Molly s story and sheds light on the pressure she and her peers endured in having to act out white stereotypes of the Indian

**The Real Rosebud** Marjorie Weinberg,2004-01-01 Her great grandfather was a famed Lakota warrior her father a buffalo hunter and Rosebud Yellow Robe hosted a CBS radio show in New York City From buffalo hunting to the hub of twentieth century urban life this book chronicles the momentous changes in the life of a prominent Plains Indian family over three generations At the center of the story is Rosebud 1907-92 whose personal recollections family memoirs letters and stories form the basis of this book Rosebud s father Chauncey Yellow Robe was the son of a Lakota chief and had a traditional childhood until he was sent to the Carlisle Indian School where he became an advocate for Indian education and citizenship He was instrumental in planning the 1927 ceremony that brought his daughter into national prominence an induction of Calvin Coolidge into the Lakota tribe capped by Rosebud placing a feathered war bonnet on the president s head Marjorie Weinberg follows the young woman from Rapid City South Dakota to New York City where she became a noted lecturer and teller of Indian tales and where her broadcasting career brought her name to the attention of Orson Welles who may indeed have used her name for his famous sled in Citizen Kane Reflecting a lifelong interest and a friendship that provided Weinberg access to family archives and a rich reservoir of family oral tradition The Real Rosebud offers an intimate picture of a century and a half of a remarkable Lakota family

**Matter, Magic, and Spirit** David Murray,2013-04-23 The spiritual and religious beliefs and practices of Native Americans and African Americans have long been sources of fascination and curiosity owing to their marked difference from the religious traditions of white writers and researchers Matter Magic and Spirit explores the ways religious and magical beliefs of Native Americans and African Americans have been represented in a range of discourses including anthropology comparative religion and literature Though these beliefs were widely dismissed as

primitive superstition and inferior to higher religions like Christianity distinctions were still made between the supposed spiritual capacities of the different groups David Murray's analysis is unique in bringing together Indian and African beliefs and their representations First tracing the development of European ideas about both African fetishism and Native American primitive belief he goes on to explore the ways in which the hierarchies of race created by white Europeans coincided with hierarchies of religion as expressed in the developing study of comparative religion and folklore through the nineteenth century Crucially this comparative approach to practices that were dismissed as conjure or black magic or Indian medicine points as well to the importance of their cultural and political roles in their own communities at times of destructive change Murray also explores the ways in which Indian and African writers later reformulated the models developed by white observers as demonstrated through the work of Charles Chesnutt and Simon Pokagon and then in the later conjunctions of modernism and ethnography in the 1920s and 1930s through the work of Zora Neale Hurston Zitkala-Sa and others Later sections demonstrate how contemporary writers including Ishmael Reed and Leslie Silko deal with the revaluation of traditional beliefs as spiritual resources against a background of New Age spirituality and postmodern conceptions of racial and ethnic identity

*Viola Martinez, California Paiute* Diana Meyers Bahr, 2012-10-09 The life story of Viola Martinez an Owens Valley Paiute Indian of eastern California extends over nine decades of the twentieth century Viola experienced forced assimilation in an Indian boarding school overcame racial stereotypes to pursue a college degree and spent several years working at a Japanese American internment camp during World War II Finding herself poised uncertainly between Indian and white worlds Viola was determined to turn her marginalized existence into an opportunity for personal empowerment In *Viola Martinez California Paiute* Diana Meyers Bahr recounts Viola's extraordinary life story and examines her strategies for dealing with acculturation Bahr allows Viola to tell her story in her own words beginning with her early years in Owens Valley where she learned traditional lifeways such as gathering piñons from her aunt In the summers she traveled by horse and buggy into the High Sierras where her aunt traded with Basque shepherders Viola was sent to the Sherman Institute a federal boarding school with a mandate to assimilate American Indians into U.S. mainstream culture Punished for speaking Paiute at the boarding school Viola and her cousin climbed fifty foot palm trees to speak their native language secretly Realizing that despite her efforts she was losing her language Viola resolved not just to learn English but to master it She earned a degree from Santa Barbara State College and pursued a career as social worker During World War II Viola worked as an employment counselor for Japanese American internees at the Manzanar War Relocation Authority camp Later in life she became a teacher and worked tirelessly as a founding member of the Los Angeles American Indian Education Commission

Travellers through Empire Cecilia Morgan, 2017-11-08 In the late eighteenth century and throughout the nineteenth century an unprecedented number of Indigenous people especially Haudenosaunee Anishinaabeg and Cree travelled to Britain and other parts of the world Who were these transatlantic travellers where were they going and what

Deloria, 2004-10-18 Despite the passage of time our vision of Native Americans remains locked up within powerful stereotypes That's why some images of Indians can be so unexpected and disorienting What is Geronimo doing sitting in a Cadillac Why is an Indian woman in beaded buckskin sitting under a salon hairdryer Such images startle and challenge our outdated visions even as the latter continue to dominate relations between Native and non Native Americans Philip Deloria explores this cultural discordance to show how stereotypes and Indian experiences have competed for ascendancy in the wake of the military conquest of Native America and the nation's subsequent embrace of Native authenticity Rewriting the story of the national encounter with modernity Deloria provides revealing accounts of Indians doing unexpected things singing opera driving cars acting in Hollywood in ways that suggest new directions for American Indian history Focusing on the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries a time when according to most standard American narratives Indian people almost dropped out of history itself Deloria argues that a great many Indians engaged the very same forces of modernization that were leading non Indians to reevaluate their own understandings of themselves and their society He examines longstanding stereotypes of Indians as invariably violent

suggesting that even as such views continued in American popular culture they were also transformed by the violence at Wounded Knee. He tells how Indians came to represent themselves in Wild West shows and Hollywood films and also examines sports music and even Indian people's use of the automobile as an ironic counterpoint to today's highways teeming with Dakota pickups and Cherokee sport utility vehicles. Throughout Deloria shows us anomalies that resist pigeonholing and force us to rethink familiar expectations. Whether considering the Hollywood films of James Young Deer or the Hall of Fame baseball career of pitcher Charles Albert Bender, he persuasively demonstrates that a significant number of Indian people engaged in modernity and helped shape its anxieties and its textures at the very moment they were being defined as primitive. These secret histories Deloria suggests compel us to reconsider our own current expectations about what Indian people should be, how they should act, and even what they should look like. More important, he shows how such seemingly harmless, even if unconscious, expectations contribute to the racism and injustice that still haunt the experience of many Native American people today.

*Tall Woman* Rose Mitchell, 2001. Portrays Navajo weaver and midwife Tall Woman who held onto traditional Navajo ways, raised twelve children, and cared for the farm throughout her marriage to political leader and Blessingway singer Frank Mitchell.

*Modern Bodies* Julia L. Foulkes, 2003-11-03. In 1930 dancer and choreographer Martha Graham proclaimed the arrival of dance as an art of and from America. Dancers such as Doris Humphrey, Ted Shawn, Katherine Dunham, and Helen Tamiris joined Graham in creating a new form of dance, and like other modernists they experimented with and argued over their aesthetic innovations to which they assigned great meaning. Their innovations, however, went beyond aesthetics. While modern dancers devised new ways of moving bodies in accordance with many modernist principles, their artistry was indelibly shaped by their place in society. Modern dance was distinct from other artistic genres in terms of the people it attracted: white women, many of whom were Jewish, gay men, and African American men and women. Women held leading roles in the development of modern dance on stage, and off, gay men recast the effeminacy often associated with dance into a hardened, heroic American athleticism, and African Americans contributed elements of social African and Caribbean dance, even as their undervalued role defined the limits of modern dancers' communal visions. Through their art, modern dancers challenged conventional roles and images of gender, sexuality, race, class, and regionalism with a view of American democracy that was confrontational and participatory, authorial and populist. *Modern Bodies* exposes the social dynamics that shaped American modernism and moved modern dance to the edges of society, a place both provocative and perilous.
