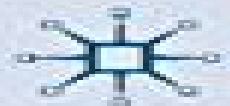

Are these neighbourhood impacts conditioned by national and welfare state contexts, by the wider metropolitan structures, and by specific neighbourhood characteristics? Various aspects of poverty, social exclusion, and integration are brought together and provide a new assessment of the place of neighbourhood within these wider debates.
