rather unique in that it reviews the principles of clinical decision making using as an example a postoperative neonate who has a respiratory emergency at night in the NICU Few chapters in the neonatal literature are devoted to this subject and the approach of this chapter makes it the gem of the book The only shortcoming is the failure to include more topics and greater depth in each chapter since the concept of explaining basic mechanisms of neonatal disease could fill a much larger book
