The book is intended for practitioners and academic scholars with interest in sustainable development, regenerative design, pattern languages, biophilia, settlement planning, and climate change adaptation.

Modernism's History Bernard Smith, 1998-01-01 The history of twentieth-century visual arts can no longer be written as a succession of avant-garde movements, contends eminent art historian Bernard Smith in this stimulating book. He argues that a return to the concept of period style is inevitable and that modernism, the dominant style of art that emerged at the end of the nineteenth century and continued through the 1960s, deserves recognition as a period style. Smith renames this period *Formalistic* since it is no longer modern and since it emphasizes the formal values of art more than any previous period does.
