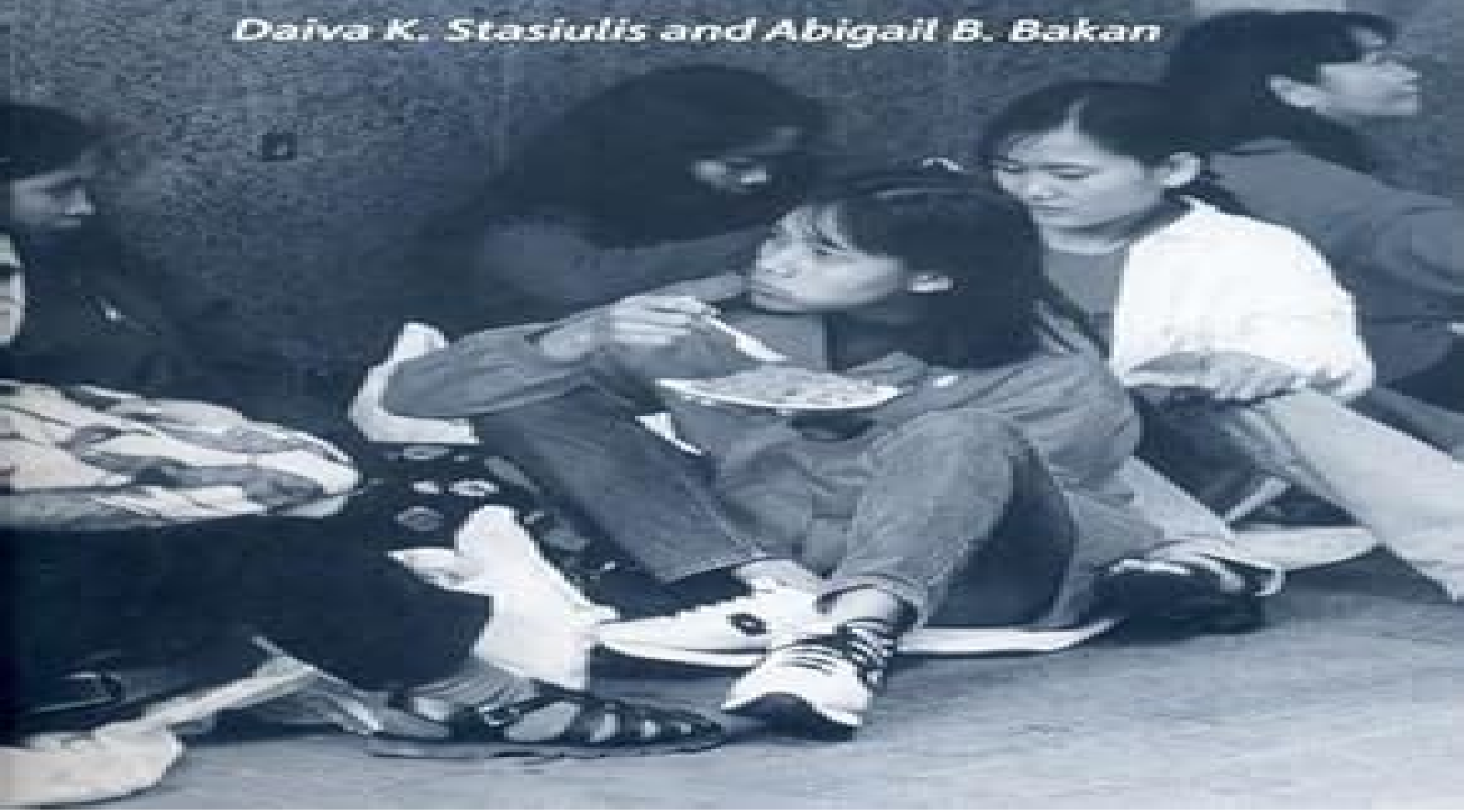

Stasiulis, 2003-12-19 *Negotiating Citizenship* explores the growing inequalities associated with nation based citizenship from the perspective of migrant women workers who have made their way from impoverished Third World countries to work in Canada in the caregiving industries of domestic service and nursing. The study demonstrates the impact of the global political economy, public and private gatekeeping mechanisms and racialized and gendered stereotypes on the contested relationship between citizen employers and non citizen female migrant workers in Canada.

Towards a Global History of Domestic and Caregiving Workers, 2015-05-26 Domestic and caregiving work has been at the core of human existence throughout history. Poorly paid or even unpaid, this work has been assigned to women in most societies and occasionally to men, often as enslaved indentured workers. While some use domestic service as training for their own future independent households, others are confined to it for life and try to avoid damage to their identities. Part One: Employment conditions are even worse in colonizer/colonized dichotomies in which the subalternized have to run the households of administrators who believe they are running an empire. Part Two: Societies and states set the discriminatory rules; those employed develop strategies of resistance or self protection. Part Three: A team of international scholars addresses these issues globally with a deep historical background.
