Motherhood in Bondage Margaret Sanger, 1928 **Motherhood in Bondage** Margaret Sanger, 2000 **Entangled** Ashley Boggan, 2025-05-06 The United Methodist impasse over human sexuality has its roots in two dichotomous ideologies of history and theology This book maps how American Methodists have responded to sexual change since World War II It argues that the current United Methodist impasse over human sexuality has its root in the existence of two dichotomous ideologies of Methodist history and theology one liberal and one evangelical which come to the foreground in discussions of human sexuality It offers evidence about how these ideologies have sought to reconcile their sexual ethic with sexual change since the birth control movement of the 1920s In post WWII America most Methodists upheld a limited notion of family life and sexuality one that allowed for the use of artificial contraception within marriage and for divorce In response to the sexual revolution liberal leaning Methodists upheld a new sexual ethic the new morality which peaked with radical new approaches to sex education a full endorsement of abortion rights and support of the homophile movement However the new morality coincided with an increased presence of and a new voice for evangelical Methodists Charles Keysor and the Good News Movement Evangelical Methodists critiqued the new morality as value neutral and anti Scripture The evangelical desire for a rules based morality solely reliant on Scripture collided with the new morality and led to intense debates over sex education abortion and the inclusion of LGBTQ persons within the United Methodist denomination from the 1970s onward Since 1972 United Methodists have continually debated human sexuality at each General Conference primarily through the advocacy efforts of political caucus groups This author hopes that an historical examination of how Methodists have confronted sexual change will enlighten current conversations about human sexuality **Mother-Work** Molly Ladd-Taylor, 2022-10-17 Early in the twentieth century maternal and child welfare evolved from a private family responsibility into a matter of national policy Molly Ladd Taylor explores both the private and public aspects of child rearing using the relationship between them to cast new light on the histories of motherhood the welfare state and women s activism in the United States Ladd Taylor argues that mother work women s unpaid work of reproduction and caregiving motivated women s public activism and maternalist ideology Mothering experiences led women to become active in the development of public health education and welfare services In turn the advent of these services altered mothering in many ways including the reduction of the infant mortality rate *The Keloids We Heal* Sarah Soanirina Ohmer, 2025-05-13 The corporeal and spiritual healing in literature by women of colors can be seen to redefine modern thought and printed text Sarah Soanirina Ohmer traces the impact of colonization and enslavement on Black women and Black women s contributions to colonial nineteenth and twentieth century literature in

respectable mainstream cause endorsed by powerful professionals and politicians alike Eschewing their early ideological commitments to obtain widespread acceptance birth controllers adopted a strategy of political accommodation characterized by deferential rhetoric and careful posturing This strategy secured significant victories for the movement but at what cost Informed by a deep commitment to reproductive justice *The Battle for Birth Control* traces the duplicity of the movement's early rhetoric and argues that their accommodationist strategy yielded increased contraceptive access solely because of their willingness to endorse the neoliberal regime of reproductive control largely responsible for the current threats to reproductive autonomy in the 21st century

Not My Mother's Sister Astrid Henry, 2004-09-07 No matter how wise a mother's advice is we listen to our peers At least that's writer Naomi Wolf's take on the differences between her generation of feminists the third wave and the feminists who came before her and developed in the late 60s and 70s the second wave In *Not My Mother's Sister* Astrid Henry agrees with Wolf that this has been the case with American feminism but says there are problems inherent in drawing generational lines Henry begins by examining texts written by women in the second wave and illustrates how that generation identified with yet also disassociated itself from its feminist foremothers Younger feminists now claim the movement as their own by distancing themselves from the past By focusing on feminism's debates about sexuality they are able to reject the so-called victim feminism of Catherine MacKinnon and Andrea Dworkin Rejecting the orthodoxies of the second wave younger feminists celebrate a woman's right to pleasure Henry asserts however that by ignoring diverse older voices the new generation has oversimplified generational conflict and has underestimated the contributions of earlier feminists to women's rights They have focused on issues relating to personal identity at the expense of collective political action Just as writers like Wolf Katie Roiphe and Rene Denfeld celebrate a new feminist hetero sexuality posited in generational terms queer and lesbian feminists of the third wave similarly distance themselves from those who came before Henry shows how 1970s lesbian feminism is represented in ways that are remarkably similar to the puritanical portrait of feminism offered by straight

third wave. She concludes by examining the central role played by feminists of color in the development of third wave feminism. Indeed the term third wave itself was coined by Rebecca Walker daughter of Alice Walker. *Not My Mother's Sister* is an important contribution to the exchange of ideas among feminists of all ages and persuasions. *Laws of Early Iceland*
