Diary of a Wartime Naval Constructor Ian Buxton, 2022-09-30 One of the most significant warship designers of the twentieth century Sir Stanley Goodall rose through the ranks of the Royal Corps of Naval Constructors to become its head in 1936. The Corps was responsible for every aspect of the design and construction of British warships and its head the Director

of Naval Construction was the principal technical advisor to the Board of Admiralty. Although Goodall was succeeded in this post in January 1944, he remained the Assistant Controller Warship Production until October 1945, so was probably the single most influential figure in British naval technical matters during the war years.
