The molecular identity of

the antigens recognized by anti tumor T cells has been elucidated and several hundreds of tumor derived antigenic peptides have been discovered Upon recognition of such peptides presented by self MHC molecules both CD8 and CD4 T cells are activated expand to high numbers and differentiate into effective anti tumor agents CD8 T cells directly destroy tumor cells and can cause even large tumors to completely regress in experimental mouse models These observations have spurred intense research activity aimed at designing and testing cancer vaccines Over 100 years ago Coley successfully used intratumoral injection of killed bacteria to treat sarcomas The important anti tumor effects observed in a fraction of these patients fueled major research efforts These led to major discoveries in the 80s and the 90s It turns out that bacterial lipopolysaccharides stimulate the production of massive amounts of a cytokine still known today as tumor necrosis factor TNF a They do so by engagement of a rather complex set of interactions culminating in the ligation of a Toll like receptor TLR 4 Ensuing signaling through this receptor initiates potent innate immune responses Unfortunately the clinical use of both TNF a and LPS can not be generalized due to their very narrow therapeutic margin Importantly synthetic Lipid A analogs have been identified that retain useful bioactivity and yet possess only mild toxicity. The relatively large body of information accumulated thus far on the molecular and cellular interactions set in motion by administration of LPS as well as by the synthetic lipid A analogs allow to place this family of bacterially derived molecules at the crossroads between innate and adaptive immunity By virtue of this key position the therapeutic applications being pursued aim at using these compounds either as direct anti tumor agents or as vaccine adjuvants The clinical experience acquired so far on these two avenues is asymmetric Few clinical trials using Lipid A analogs as single anti cancer agents involving less than 100 patients with advanced cancer have been reported In contrast lipid A has been tested in over 300 000 individuals in various vaccines trials including therapeutic cancer vaccines Clearly most of the work needed to develop lipid A as effective anti cancer agents and or as vaccine adjuvant lies ahead in the near future This book is a timely contribution and provides a much needed up to date overview of the chemical biological and physiological aspects of lipid A It should be a beacon to all those Integrins and Ion Channels Andrea Becchetti, Annarosa Arcangeli, 2010-12-28 involved in this field of research Interdisciplinarity is more often invoked than practised This is hardly surprising considering the daunting vastness of modern biology To reach a satisfactory understanding of a complex biological system a wide spectrum of conceptual and experimental tools must be applied at different levels from the molecular to the cellular tissue and organismic We believe the multifaceted regulatory interplay between integrin receptors and ion channels offers a rich and challenging field for researchers seeking broad biological perspectives By mediating cell adhesion to the extracellular matrix integrins regulate many developmental processes in the widest sense from cell choice between differentiation and proliferation to tissue remodeling and organogenesis Rapidly growing evidence shows that frequent communication takes place between cell adhesion receptors and channel proteins This may occur through formation of multiprotein membrane complexes that

regulate ion fluxes as well as a variety of intracellular signaling pathways In other cases cross talk is more indirect and mediated by cellular messengers such as G proteins These interactions are reciprocal in that ion channel stimulation often controls integrin activation or expression From a functional standpoint studying the interplay between integrin receptors and ion channels clarifies how the extracellular matrix regulates processes as disparate as muscle excitability synaptic plasticity and lymphocyte activation just to mention a few The derangement of these processes has many implications for pathogenesis processes in particular for tumor invasiveness and some cardiovascular and neurologic diseases This book provides a general introduction to the problems and methods of this blossoming field **Modelling Parasite Transmission and Control** Edwin Michael, Robert C. has dramatically changed and evolved with ever more emerging venues to explore for 3Rs advancement and implementation The Mononuclear Phagocyte System in Infectious Disease Geanncarlo Lugo-Villarino, Céline Cougoule, Etienne Meunier, Yoann Rombouts, Christel Vérollet, Luciana Balboa, 2019-10-04 The Mononuclear Phagocyte System MPS of vertebrates is composed of monocytes macrophages and dendritic cells Together they form part of the first line of immune defense against a variety of pathogens bacteria fungi parasites and viruses and thus play an important role in maintaining organism homeostasis The mode of transmission type of replication and mechanism of disease causing differ significantly for each pathogen eliciting a unique immune response in the host Within this context the MPS acts as both the sentinel and tailor of the immune system As sentinels MPS cells are found in blood and within tissues throughout the body to patrol against pathogenic insult The strategy to detect microbial non self relies on MPS to recognize conserved microbial products known as pathogen associated molecular pattern PAMPs PAMPs recognition represents a checkpoint in the response to pathogens and relies on conserved pattern recognition receptors PRRs Upon PRR engagement MPS mount a cell autonomous attack that includes the internalization and compartmentalization of intracellular pathogens into toxic compartments that promote destruction In parallel MPS cells launch an inflammatory response composed of a cellular arm and soluble factors to control extracellular pathogens In cases when innate immunity fails to eliminate the invading microbe MPS serves as a tailor to generate adaptive immunity for pathogen eradication and generation of memory cells thus ensuring enhanced protection against re infection Indeed MPS cell functions comprise the capture process migration and delivery of antigenic information to lymphoid organs where type 1 immunity is tailored against intracellular microbes and type 2 immunity against extracellular pathogens However this potent adaptive immunity is also a double edge sword that can cause aberrant inflammatory disorders like autoimmunity or chronic inflammation For this reason MPS also tailors tolerance immunity against unwanted inflammation Successful clearance of the microbe results in its destruction and proper collection of debris resolution of inflammation and tissue healing for which MPS is essential Reciprocally as part of the evolutionary process taking place in all organisms microbes evolved strategies to circumvent the actions bestowed by MPS cells Multiple pathogens modulate the differentiation maturation and activation programs of the MPS as an efficient strategy to avoid a dedicated immune response Among the most common evasion strategies are the subversion of phagocytosis inhibition of PRR mediated immunity resistance to intracellular killing by reactive oxygen and nitrogen species restriction of phagosome

maturation modulation of cellular metabolism and nutrient acquisition regulation of cell death and autophagy and modulation of pro inflammatory responses and hijacking of tolerance mechanisms among others.
