Ancestrally, the focus of this volume is upon the four Carter brothers: Simeon, John, S. Gideon, and Jared, who joined the Mormon Church in the 1831-32 period. While Simeon, the author's great-great-grandfather, did not keep a journal, Gideon's journal is very brief, Jared's is one of the most important documents in early Mormon history, and John's shorter journal is also very valuable. Jared was a kind of religious fanatic with utopian views on faith, healing, the power of prayer, and prophecy, yet nevertheless he became president of the Kirtland High Council and a member of the prestigious three-man Kirtland Temple Building Committee. John became a leader of the Church in the northeastern New York/Vermont region and brought a large company of saints to Kirtland in early 1833. All four Carter brothers became important early missionaries, and four separate chapters document their activities.
