Précis of Moral Dimensions: Permissibility, Meaning, Blame

Moral Dimensions is concerned with the way in which an agent's aims in acting, and more generally what he or she sees as reasons for acting in that particular way, are relevant to the permissibility of that action, or to other forms of moral assessment. As the title indicates, one central theme of the book is the importance of distinguishing different forms of moral assessment, some of which depend on agents' reasons for acting in ways that other forms of assessment do not.

Chapter I is concerned with whether an agent's reasons are relevant to the permissibility of an action in the way claimed by the Doctrine of Double Effect. I have never found this doctrine intrinsically plausible. But for many years I was inclined to accept it because it seemed to provide the only satisfactory explanation of certain cases. It seemed, for example, to be the best explanation of the distinction between tactical bombing and terror bombing. It also seemed to explain why it is permissible to use the all of the available amount of a drug to save five people even thought this means that another person, who could be saved only by giving him all of the available supply, will die, but not permissible to withhold all of the drug from that person in order to save five others by transplanting his organs after he has died.

In this chapter I argue that there are other, better explanations of these cases. The tendency to think that they support the Doctrine of Double Effect arises, I suggest, from a failure to distinguish between two ways of employing a moral principle to assess what an agent has done: what I call the *deliberative* use of a principle, to determine the permissibility of acting in this way, and the *critical* use of a principle, to assess the way in which the agent went about deciding what to do. The latter form of assessment always depends on what the agent saw as reasons whereas the former need not do so.
