Mountain Hands Sam Venable, 2000 Hazel Pendley creates heirloom quality quilts Ed Ripley wraps bits of fur and feathers into trout flies the size of gnats Edna Hartong still makes an item that has all but disappeared from the American scene lye soap All of these people and many more like them are Appalachians who work with their hands Journalist Sam Venable and photographer Paul Efird spent four years combing the hills and hollows of Southern Appalachia to find these talented individuals and let them talk about their work Mountain Hands is an intimate look at more than three dozen such craftspeople and their vocations Venable and Efird encountered folks who pursue popular crafts such as basketweaving and clockmaking But they found practitioners of other trades wallpaper hangers and rail splitters beekeepers and gravediggers whose work also depends upon dexterity and upon expressing a distinctive Appalachian way of life Some are college educated some can barely read and write some have lived in these hills all their lives others have only recently come to call them home Yet each feels bound to the region through a deep sense of belonging and each owes at least part of his or her livelihood to handwork While most of us may think of working with one s hands as entering computer data these individuals attest to the perseverance and appeal of more traditional ways Mountain Hands is a celebration in words and photographs of gifted people who understand and appreciate the Appalachian heritage and who live it every day The Author A fifth generation southern Appalachian Sam Venable is a newspaper columnist whose award winning observations on daily life appear four times a week in the Knoxville News Sentinel A graduate of the University of Tennessee Venable has spent most of his career roaming the highlands of his home state He and his wife Mary Ann also a Tennessee native and UT graduate live in a log house atop a wooded ridge on the outskirts of Knoxville The Photographer Paul Efird is a native of Rome Georgia He holds a degree in biology from Shorter College but has spent his professional career as a news photographer After working for two newspapers in Georgia he moved to Tennessee in 1990 and became a staff photographer for the News Sentinel Efird is an avid hiker canoeist and backpacker He and his wife Stephanie live in Knoxville Appalachian Folkways John B. Rehder, 2004-07-12 Winner of the Kniffen Award and an Honorable Mention from the Professional and Scholarly Publishing Awards in Sociology and Anthropology Appalachia may be the most mythologized and misunderstood place in America its way of life and inhabitants both caricatured and celebrated in the mainstream media Over generations though the families living in the mountainous region stretching from West Virginia to northeastern Alabama have forged one of the country s richest and most distinctive cultures encompassing music food architecture customs and language In Appalachian Folkways geographer John Rehder offers an engaging and enlightening account of southern Appalachia and its cultural milieu that is at once sweeping and intimate From architecture and traditional livelihoods to beliefs and art Rehder who has spent thirty years studying the region offers a nuanced depiction of southern Appalachia's social and cultural identity. The book opens with an expert consideration of the southern Appalachian landscape defined by mountains rocky soil thick forests and

plentiful streams While these features have shaped the inhabitants of the region Rehder notes Appalachians have also shaped their environment and he goes on to explore the human influence on the landscape From physical geography the book moves to settlement patterns describing the Indian tribes that flourished before European settlement and the successive waves of migration that brought Melungeon Scotch Irish English and German settlers to the region along with the cultural contributions each made to what became a distinct Appalachian culture Next focusing on the folk culture of Appalachia Rehder details such cultural expressions as architecture and landscape design traditional and more recent ways of making a living both legal and illegal foodstuffs and cooking techniques folk remedies and belief systems music art and the folk festivals that today attract visitors from around the world and the region s dialect With its broad scope and deep research Appalachian Folkways accurately and evocatively chronicles a way of life that is fast disappearing **Farmer's Story** Diane Asséo Griliches, 2007 In contrast to the generally negative view of Appalachia as a subculture of hopeless poverty and deprivation this book shows a very different picture Roy Anderson was a resourceful though poor farmer but also a talented cabinetmaker musical instrument maker and lay preacher and at age 80 he tells with modesty the story of his life Roy's words are accompanied by evocative black and white photographs descriptive of his life with his sister on the farm his cabinet shop the community and his church life They give a pictorial dimension to a hard but enterprising life lived with dignity on one of the few remaining small farms in a particular community in southwestern Virginia Roy begins by telling of his earliest memories As these are becoming things of the past we can all learn a great deal about life in Roy s time and place while gaining insight into an inspiring life in a rich American culture most of us would like to know more about

Rehder, 2012-12-30 Drawing on more than four decades of research Tennessee heart Log Buildings examines one of the Volunteer State's most precious and fast disappearing traditions From the pioneer era through the mid twentieth century folk builders in Tennessee used logs to construct cabins barns other outbuildings schools and churches In warm accessible prose that often makes this deeply researched work read like guidebook John Rehder explores the varied styles and architectural characteristics of these fascinating structures including their floor plans the types of timber used and the different notches that were cut into the logs to secure the structures Profusely illustrated with over one hundred images Tennessee Log Houses traces the evolution of log houses from one room or single pen dwellings to more elaborate homes of various types such as saddlebags Cumberland houses dogtrots and two story I houses Rehder discusses the historic settlement patterns and building traditions that led to this variety of house types and identifies their particular occurrences throughout the state by drawing on surveys conducted in forty two counties by teams working for the Tennessee Historical Commission THC Similarly he explores disparate barn and outbuilding types including the distinctive cantilever barns that are found predominantly in East Tennessee Sprinkled throughout the book are engaging anecdotes that convey just what it is like to conduct field research in remote rural areas Rehder also describes in detail a number of the state s exceptional log places among them Wynnewood an enormous structure in Middle Tennessee which dates back to the

A College For Appalachia P. David Searles, 2021-05-11 Alice Spencer Geddes Lloyd was a New England woman with a mission in life In 1916 she settled on Caney Creek in Eastern Kentucky determined to bring higher education to this remote corner of Appalachia The school she founded now Alice Lloyd College continues to serve the area and its people and to stand as a tribute to Lloyd's remarkable energy determination and vision Lloyd's program combined a rigorous academic curriculum with an intense effort to instill a sense of service in the school's graduates This education was provided free and required only that the students abide by Lloyd's strict rules of conduct and pledge to remain in the mountains after graduating In the first full scale study of Lloyd's life and work and the institution she founded David Searles shows how this courageous and complex woman struggled throughout her long life against seemingly insurmountable odds to create an institution dedicated to improving life in Appalachia But as he acknowledges Lloyd's fundraising activities relied on harmful stereotypes that caused resentment among her mountain neighbors and she often angered others working in the mountains Despite the negative aspects of Lloyd's activities Searles casts serious doubt on the now fashionable conclusion that the women who came to the mountains to do good created more problems than they solved Lloyd's story he argues demonstrates that much good was indeed accomplished and that the people of the mountains recognized and appreciated her achievement
