- The study is a social science field that analysis and identifies violent and nonviolent behaviour as well as the structural mechanisms attending conflicts (including social conflicts), with a view towards understanding those procedures that lead to a more desirable human condition.
- The field recognizes that conflict is inherent in human behavior and seeks to harness conflict through nonviolent means to reduce violence and transform societies.
- Peace studies provides undergraduates with the opportunity to see the world as it ought to be, rather than simply how it is.
- It equips the students with the knowledge to understand the root causes of violent conflict, develop nonviolent ways of resolving violence, and building a peaceful community.
- Unlike other declining specializations happening in some other fields, Peace Studies has continued to expand since then.
