taxes Contrary to previous results in that literature the author shows here that state governments will provide redistribution through taxes and that in a symmetric equilibrium the overall tax schedule that combines the actions of both the federal and state governments is the same as that of a unitary government This implies that under the conditions analyzed in the model there is no reason to restrict income redistribution objectives to the federal government only as commonly prescribed in the literature
