gold pieces of creating a masterpiece - which became the property of the academy and  
remained an exhibition in its monthly rooms in the Louvre. But only was the subject

usually assigned (French subjects or tales from Renaissance literature in order to facil-  
itate discussion with the museum that would become their work-in-trade in later  
decades' commitment.<sup>1</sup>

However, the academy was also anxious to prove individuality and did not prevent  
its choice a subject to Watteau, for example, of whose originality its other members were  
well aware. Exceptionally, he was allowed to paint a subject 'à la mode' - even though it  
was, like his own, and required members to produce one of his greatest masterpieces,  
whose precise subject - there is some - dated around 1710-15.<sup>2</sup> And although  
Watteau was given no indication of how large his museum display should be, the fact  
that he chose was far more significant than that he consistently employed for his  
pictures. In fact, the *Salon de Watteau* is the standard size of the historical gallery  
pictures produced by history painters for their submission to the academy.<sup>3</sup> Watteau's  
masterpiece was of a similar order, and because no less than subject matter remains a key  
to understanding them.
