assimilated into the Han Chinese culture and population Between eras of multiple kingdoms and warlordism Chinese dynasties have ruled parts or all of China in some eras control stretched as far as Xinjiang and Tibet as at present Traditional culture and influences from other parts of Asia and the Western world carried by waves of immigration cultural assimilation expansion and foreign contact form the basis of the modern culture of China
