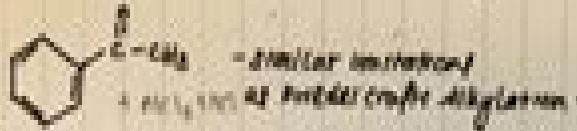

- reversible
- Sulfonation: strong acid

- Limitations**
- only alkyl halides (aromatics require too T in energy)
 - can't nitrate with aromatic substituted with strongly electron-withdrawing eg: carbonyl / halogens
 - difficult to stop after single substitution
 - Multiple rearrangements of alkyl carbocation sometimes occur (alkylthiobenzene photo)
