

She documents how during the iyawo year the ritual slowly transforms the initiate s identity For the first three months for instance the iyawo may not use a mirror even to shave and must eat all meals while seated on a mat on the floor using only a spoon and their own set of dishes During the entire year the iyawo loses their name and is simply addressed as iyawo by family and friends Carr also shows that this year long religious ritual which is carried out even as the iyawo goes about daily life offers new insight into religion in general suggesting that the sacred is not separable from the profane and indeed that religion shares an ongoing
