advocated new sentencing structures probation parole and rehabilitative regimes within new institutions for young first offenders called reformatories McClaughry then successfully got these reformatory ideals placed into adult prisons In addition McClaughry became American s main advocate for a criminal identification method called the Bertillon system He set up the first identification bureaus at the Illinois State Penitentiary the Chicago police department and the federal prison at Leavenworth Kansas and these became models for others across the country Finally as a founding member of the National Association of Chiefs of Police today the International Association of Chiefs of Police and the National Prison Association today American Corrections Association McClaughry sought to professionalize police and prison administrators
