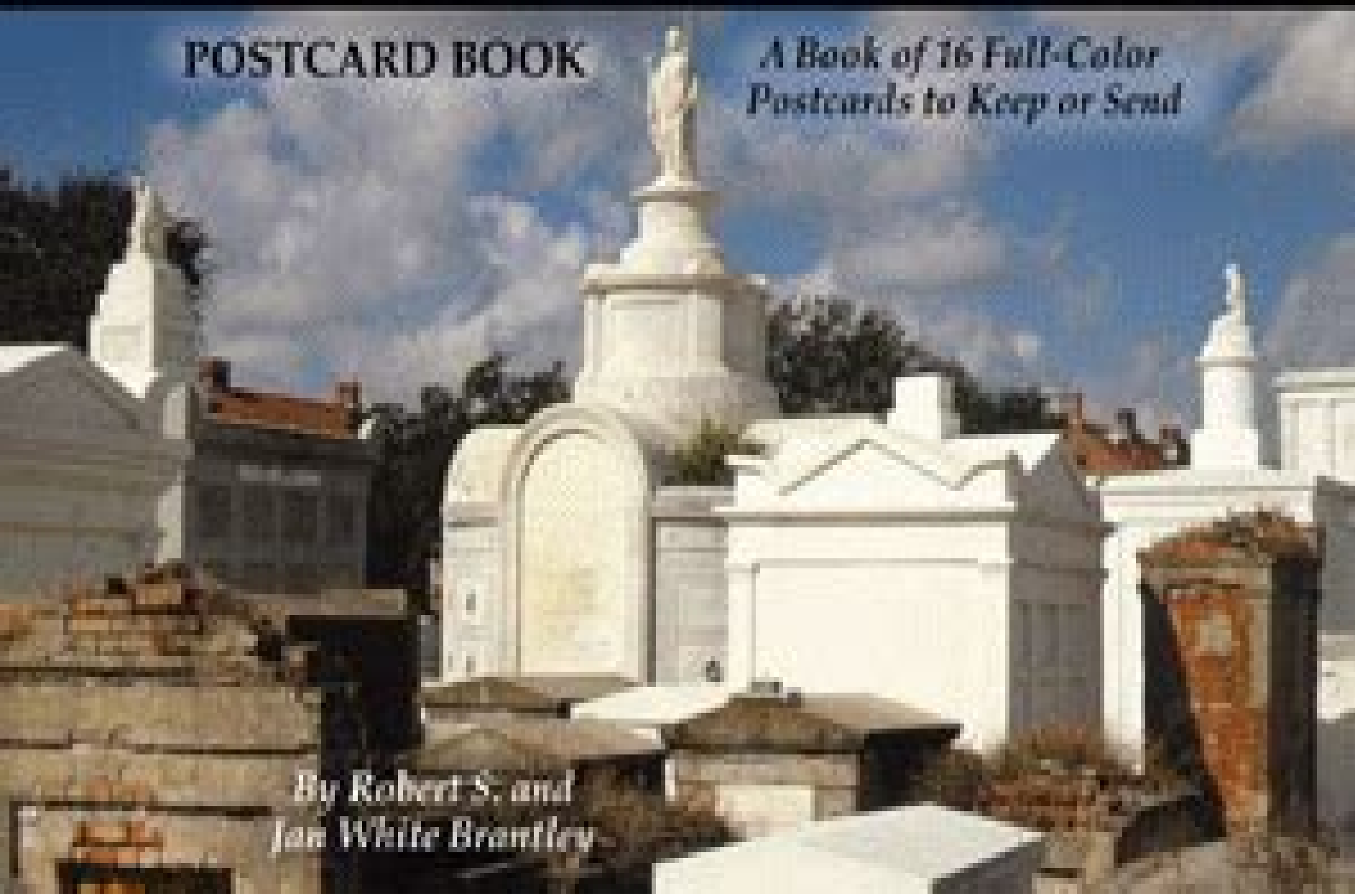

Stanonis,2024-10-08 The Creole praline arrived in New Orleans with the migration of formerly enslaved people fleeing Louisiana plantations after the Civil War Black women street vendors made a livelihood by selling a range of homemade foods including pralines to Black dockworkers and passersby The praline offered a path to financial independence and even its ingredients spoke of a history of Black ingenuity an enslaved horticulturist played a key role in domesticating the pecan and creating the grafted tree that would form the basis of Louisiana's pecan orchards By the 1880s however white New Orleans writers such as Grace King and Henry Castellanos had begun to recast the history of the praline in a nostalgic mode that harkened back to the prewar South In
