**Mi vida junto a Pablo Neruda** Matilde Urrutia,1997 Matilde Urrutia relata en esta obra conmovedora sus años de convivencia con Pablo Neruda El libro arranca con la muerte del poeta en 1973 y alterna luego los recuerdos desde inicios de los años cincuenta con escenas incluso posteriores a la muerte de Neruda pero relacionadas con la condición emblemática que el escritor y su viuda adquieren en la realidad chilena de los últimos lustros No sólo Chile empero sino muy variados lugares del mundo de Capri a Praga de Moscú a París son escenarios de esta evocación extraordinariamente rica en pormenores y percances nada conocidos animada por la coartagiosa pasión vital de un Neruda que convertido ya en mito literario no pierde ante los ojos del lector su sentido del humor ni cierta juvenil capacidad de entusiasmo Complemento indispensable y precioso de las memorias del escritor **Mi vida junto a Pablo Neruda** es un testimonio de primer orden acerca de la vida de un poeta mayor de nuestro tiempo
