

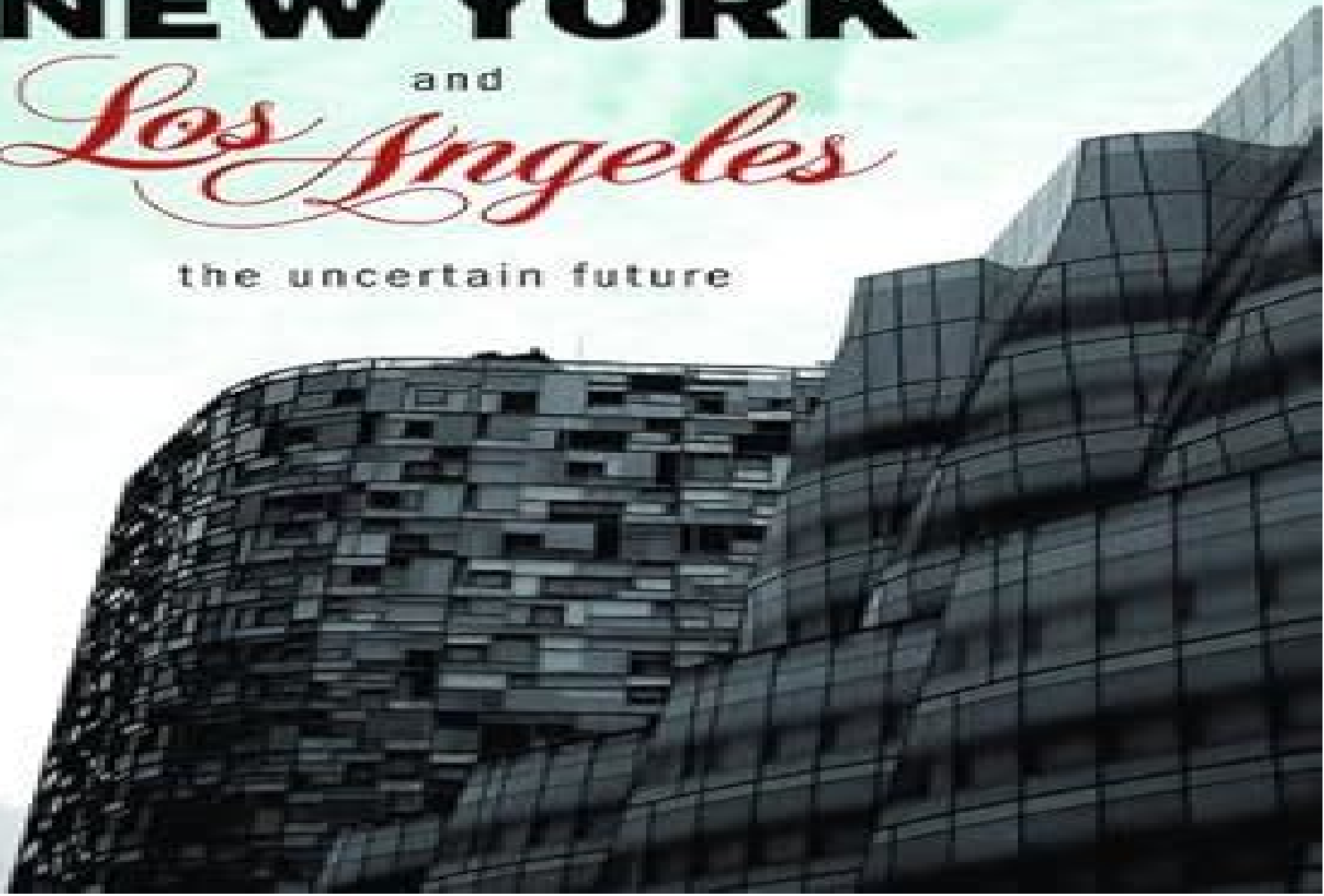

Anna Maria Bounds, 2020-06-04 Increasing American fear about terrorism environmental catastrophes pandemics and economic crises has fueled interest in prepping confronting disaster by mastering survivalist skills This trend of self reliance is not merely evidence of the American belief in the power of the individual rather this pragmatic shift away from expecting government aid during a disaster reflects a weakened belief in the bond between government and its citizens during a time of crisis This ethnographic study explores the rise of the urban preppers subculture in New York City shedding light on the distinctive approach of city dwellers in preparing for disaster With attention to the role of factors such as class race gender and one's expectations of government it shows that how one imagines Doomsday affects how one prepares for it Drawing on participant observation the author explores preppers views on the central question of whether to bug out or hunker down in the event of disaster and examines the ways in which the prepper economy increases revenue by targeting concerns over developing skills building networks securing equipment and arranging a safe locale A rich qualitative study *Bracing for the Apocalypse* will appeal to scholars of sociology and anthropology with interests in urban studies ethnography and subcultures

enliven and defend their neighborhoods Los Angeles is well known as a sprawling metropolis with endless freeways that can make the city feel isolating and separate its communities Yet in the past decade as Jan Lin argues in *Taking Back the Boulevard* there has been a noticeable renewal of public life on several of the city's iconic boulevards including Atlantic Crenshaw Lankershim Sunset Western and Wilshire These arteries connect neighborhoods across the city traverse socioeconomic divides and ethnic enclaves and can be understood as the true locational heart of public life in the metropolis Focusing especially on the cultural scene of Northeast Los Angeles Lin shows how these gentrifying communities help satisfy a white middle class consumer demand for authentic experiences of living on the edge and a spirit of cultural rebellion These neighborhoods have gone through several stages from streetcar suburbs to disinvested neighborhoods with the construction of freeways and white flight to immigrant enclaves to the home of Chicano artists in the 1970s Those artists were then followed by non-Chicano white artists who were later threatened with displacement by gentrifiers attracted by the neighborhoods culture street life and green amenities that earlier inhabitants had worked to create Lin argues that gentrification is not a single transition but a series of changes that disinvest and re-invest neighborhoods with financial and cultural capital Drawing on community survey research interviews with community residents and leaders and ethnographic observation this book argues that the revitalization in Northeast LA by arts leaders and neighborhood activists marks a departure in the political culture from the older civic engagement to more socially progressive coalition work involving preservationists environmentalists citizen protestors and arts organizers Finally Lin explores how accelerated gentrification and mass displacement of Latino and working class households in the 2010s has sparked new rounds of activism as the community grapples with new class conflicts and racial divides in the struggle to self-determine its future

Race/Class Conflict and Urban Financial Threat Jennifer L. Hochschild, 2024-12-19 Race and class inequality are at the crux of many policy disputes in American cities But are they the only factors driving political discord In *Race Class Conflict and Urban Financial Threat* political scientist Jennifer L. Hochschild examines significant policies in four major American cities to determine when race and class shape city politics when they do not and what additional forces have the power to shape urban policy choices Hochschild investigates the root causes of disputes in the arenas of policing development schooling and budgeting She finds that race and class are central to the Stop Question Frisk policing policy in New York City and the development of Atlanta's Beltline New York's Stop Question Frisk policy was intended to fight crime and keep all New Yorkers safe In practice however young Black and Latino men in low income neighborhoods were disproportionately stopped by a predominantly White police force The goal of the Atlanta Beltline a redevelopment project that includes public parks new housing commercial development and a robust public transit system is to expand access around the city and keep working class residents in the city by constructing affordable housing Instead the construction completed thus far has encouraged gentrification and displacement of poor disproportionately Black residents and has increased the wealth and power of both Black and White city elites However Hochschild finds that race and class inequality are not central to all urban policy disputes When investigating the issues of charter schools in Los Angeles and Chicago's pension system she identifies a third driver financial threat that feels existential to the policy and political actors In Los Angeles there is a battle between traditional public schools and independent charter schools Increasingly families with sufficient resources are moving out of L.A. to areas with better school districts Traditional public schools and charter schools must fight for the remaining students and the funding that comes with them There are not enough students to teach and not enough money to teach them The school district risks school closures layoffs and pension deficits in this context race class conflict fades into the background

Chicago's public sector pension debt is at least three times as large as the city's annual budget and continues to grow. Policy actors agree that the pension system needs to be stably funded. Yet city leaders fearful of upsetting constituents and jeopardizing their political careers fail to implement policies that would do so. Meaningful policy change to rectify the pension deficit continues to get kicked down the line for future policy actors to address. In this context also race class conflict fades into the background. *Race Class Conflict and Urban Financial Threat* is a compelling examination of the role that race class and political and fiscal threat play in shaping urban policy.
